

AUX-IN on the head unit of AlfaRomeo

(A head unit made in Blaupunkt, for Alfa147 and Alfa156)


At first AlfaRomeo's head unit(made in Blaupunkt) does not have AUX-IN.However,you can add AUX-IN by two next methods.

1. When your car has CDC, use Audio Selector. Fig.1






2. When your car does not have CDC, attach a switch like figure 2.




Because the output is low in the case of iPod, it is needed the amplifier . I use Belkin Auto Kit for iPod as an amplifier and a power supply.







In case of Alfa,probably a CDC protocol of Blaupunkt is compatible with C-bus(Cralion).(CDC of Alfa156SW is made in Clarion.)
You can use a connector of CDC and make AUX-IN.
Head Unit accepts the input from CDC if you jump DATA-IN and DATA-OUT.

Operation order


- 1. Switch off HeadUnit

When use CD of HEAD UNIT


Operation order
